## DAV VOLUNTEER DRIVER PROGRAM



SC DAV Organizations and DORN VA Medical Center Volunteer Services offer van rides to Veterans with medical appointments at Dorn VA Medical Center Only.

To schedule a ride, call **803-695-7949** to make an appointment.

Reservations for a van ride must be made **no later than one calendar week before your appointment.**

All medical appointments must be:

- no earlier than 9 am
- and no later than 12 noon.

There are 15 available days from which to you can choose to reserve a van ride. *\*\*Veterans must have proof of medical appointment at DORN VA.*

You may bring a caregiver with you, if there is an open seat not needed by a Veteran with an appointment.

Reservations for a van ride are on a first-come/first-serve basis. There are only 6 available seats in one round-trip.
